‘THE BEAUTY OF IT’ BY ÀNGEL DURAN AT THE FESTIVAL PORTALBLAU



The Beauty of It

The actor, dancer and performer Àngel Duran will offer the **The Beauty of It** show, on August 10, at 10 p.m., in the gardens of the Greek wall of Ampurias (L'Escala, Girona), within the Festival Portalblau (<https://portalblau.cat/>).

Influenced by philosophy and theater, the artist explores the human condition through body language and new dramaturgies, the poetry of movement and emotional expression. In this sense, **The Beauty of It** is a dance piece inspired by documentaries from the fifties and by the theories of Carl Jung, an eminent psychoanalyst, about the conscious and the unconscious, reality and dreams. The proposal speaks of the fragility of man and reflects on the masks that he puts on to hide his true identity. Is everything we experience real? What is the difference between acting and behaving as we are? Duran uses the real recording of an interview with Jung from 1957 to plunge us into a show made of gestures and introspection. **The Beauty of It** is a study of the human soul, a mirror where we can all see ourselves reflected. In addition, the show has received the first prize from the Stuttgart International Solo Festival, the prize from the Sólodos en danza contest in Ourense and a special mention from the Cortoindanza from Cagliari. It also has the support of the Festival Sismògraf.
